Video Submission Instructions

Instructions and scholarship prompts are outlined below:

Introduction

The introduction should be brief and provide a clear understanding of who you are. Use a tailored version of the following guide:

"Hello, my name is (First, Last) and I currently attend (college/university) where I am studying (major). I served in the (branch) as a (role) from (year) to (year). I am applying for the scholarship because (reason)."

Answer The Following Prompts

o Tell us about your background, why you joined the service.

- What are you studying and why? What are your career goals?
- o How have you demonstrated leadership and engagement in your community?
- o What would receiving this scholarship mean to you?

Conclusion

Use a tailored version of the following guide:

"Thank you to (*Scholarship Partner* and Student Veterans of America for the opportunity to apply for this Scholarship."

Tips To Capture Your Video

- 1-2 minutes is the recommended video timeframe.
 - Videos that go significantly over or under this timeframe will be less competitive in consideration
- Aim to convey your personality by presenting your personal story and background
- Photographs can also be included that help add to the story dialogue, but is not required
- Present a professional and collegial demeanor- i.e. clean background, professional attire
- Be willing to complete multiple takes until you are happy and confident with the final version
- Consider lighting and angle
- Audio Check
 - > Test the sound quality of your environment, and avoid a background noise



Submitting the Video

Submitting your video via LinkedIn (encouraged):

- 1. Sign-in to LinkedIn and go to your personal homepage.
- 2. At the top where it says, "Start a post," click the video icon and upload your video file
- 3. NOTE: files may be uploaded up to 5GB, so if your file is larger, consider submitting by the second option below
- 4. Add a post description to your video with a concise and thoughtful comment
 - "Check out my submission for the @StudentVeteransofAmerica (Insert Scholarship Name Here) Scholarship."
- 5. Confirm your privacy settings are correct and set your post to be visible to the public and share
- 6. the post.
- 7. Go to the post in your feed and click the three-dot icon in the upper right corner, click "copy link to post" on the drop-down menu
- 8. Finally, paste the link of your video in your application
 - a. Sign-in to your MySVA account, "My Success Hub", then go to your scholarship application
 - b. In your application, paste your link under "Video Submission"
- 9. Note: Ensure the link works by clicking on it to test

Submitting By Uploading Your Video Directly from Your Device

- 1. Sign-in to your MySVA account, "My Success Hub", then go to your scholarship application
- 2. In your application, on the right-hand side you will "Files"
- 3. Upload your video under "Video Submission" then "Upload" or "Add Files"
